#### Discussion topics

- **Leckhampton war memorial refurbishment**  
Three quotes have been requested to clean, re landscape and add another bench to make the area look better
- **Church Road Pedestrian crossing**  
Two locations are being investigated. Cllr Nelson to share the options being considered
- **Green space signage**  
Cllr Horwood has drafted the content and size required. The Clerk to get quotes to produce. Already agreed that CIL will be used to pay for these
- **Litter picks**  
Cllr Mistry to chase Steve Mason at GCC. We are hoping to have equipment at The Dug Out café so residents can use them as and when. Need to agree a process with café owner and LRFC
- **Pilley Nature Reserve**  
Cllr Davies met with two of the trustees to discuss what could be done to enhance the area. The Clerk has sent them an S137 application form
- **Lotts Meadow**  
The clerk to investigate Marsh Land value for the field and calculate how much the PC could offer to buy the land from Vistry
- **High School Leckhampton**  
The Chair and Clerk met with the Head to discuss ways the PC and the school could work together. They have submitted a CIL application, which will be discussed at the Finance Committee CIL meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> February.
