After a big response to last year's consultation, your parish council is consulting on a revised version of the **Neighbourhood Plan** we want to guide future development in Leckhampton and Warden Hill, help to safeguard our precious green spaces, protect our heritage and encourage all local authorities to deliver on your priorities including climate action, safer and cleaner travel and reduced flood risk.



As you asked, the revised plan is shorter and easier to read. It has more evidence attached in appendices covering everything from local landscape value, where we want better cycle links, our population and social profile and more.

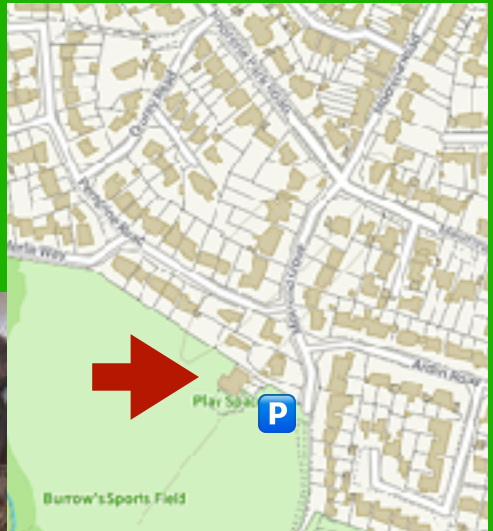
