

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER**  
**490628 KIDNAPPERS LANE (LECKHAMPTON AND WARDEN HILL PARISH)**  
**CHELTENHAM BOROUGH ORDER 2021**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for the 490628 Kidnappers Lane from outside the property known as Fremar to its junction with Farm Lane for a distance of approximately 140 metres ("the Road") is satisfied that use of the Road should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Road;
2. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road;
3. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road;
4. The Road falls in Leckhampton and Warden Hill Parish in the Cheltenham Borough and in the County of Gloucestershire;
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 10<sup>th</sup> January Two Thousand and Twenty Two and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months;
6. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Traffic Order 490628 Kidnappers Lane (Leckhampton and Warden Hill Parish) Cheltenham Borough Order 2021".
7. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
